

## Happy Anniversary To Niwot

Next year is the 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the platting of Niwot in 1875 so the Niwot Historical Society plans to publish a booklet reflecting the timeline of growth and development in our community.

If anyone would like to help with some of the research, please let us know because there are a few years that are a little lean with information.

NHS member Judy (Gould) Dayhoff has found some interesting newspaper articles about the early years. Here re a couple samples:

**1894** – Cheese Factory – The people of Ni Wot are erecting a cheese factory which is to be ready for operation about May 1. *The Rocky Mountain News (Daily), Volume 35, April 14, 1894.* 

Flooding - Frank Bader, of Ni Wot reported that part of the Springdale bowling alley has floated to Ni Wot. He came for the mail and said that the Knaus' and other farmers were driven from their homes which are covered with water. The railroad bridge over Left Hand (creek) and all wagon bridges are washed out, Left Hand (creek) is 300 yeads wide a mile from Ni Wot. *Boulder Daily Camera, June 2, 1894*.
